A SIGN OF TIME (10 min. Super 8)

A short film about an oral Deaf college student who is just discovering her deaf identity. Actors: Tanya Ingram, Dawn Rose, Carlos Rexace & Danny Blakley.

RECOLLECTION (3 min. 16mm)

The story of a young athlete's whose dreams of playing professional sports only to her disappointment, suddenly ended abruptly. (Starring by Jade)

A FEELING OF SILENCE (5 min. 16mm)

A short film about a Deaf woman whose boyfriend left her out in a group of hearing friends as a result threatens their new found relationship. Actors: Rhondee Beriault and Joshua Lay

MARRIAGE OR COMING OUT (5 min. 16mm)

A short film about a Deaf Gay man struggling with sexual identity problem, unsure whether to marry his high school sweetheart or come out to her before matters get worse. Actors: Jeff Mooney and Rhondee Beriault

DAGGER (7 min. Video)

An improvisation interview about a female Deaf prisoner on death row. Starring Jade

CUTTING THE EDGE OF A FREE BIRD (15 min. 16mm)

A short film about a confused Deaf lesbian high school girl struggling to decide between a deaf or hearing college while her Deaf mother tries to make her life like her own. Actors: Michelle Banks, Opal Gordon & Adrienne Morgan

LISTEN TO THE HANDS OF OUR PEOPLE (82 min. Video)

An award winning documentary about seven H.I.V. positive Deaf and Hard of Hearing people living with AIDS. They also talk about coping with fears, fears of dying, being alone, and accepting it.

ON & OFF STAGE: THE BRUCE HUBOK STORY (182 min. Video)

A documentary story about a frustrated Deaf theater artist who claimed fame on Broadway at such a young age until illness cuts his acting and writing career short. He was also a misunderstood and controversial artist

REACHING ZENITH: A BLACK FILMMAKER'S JOURNEY takes you on a journey into the world of a very determined African-American Deaf filmmaker, her work, and personal video diaries revealing her battle and conquer of inner demons which occurred during production. Jade's film celebrates the trials and tribulations of her career as a filmmaker for 15 years.

9/11 FEAR IN SILENCE: THE FORGOTTEN UNDERDOGS (Feature Documentary)

Two versions 88 mins. & 144 mins. – Video 2006) A documentary based on stories by Deaf and Hard of Hearing civilians who witnessed and survived the horror of September 11 attacks at the WTC. (Completed/Copyright 2006)

IF YOU COULD HEAR MY OWN TUNE, formerly known as SOMALIA: A LOVE STORY (Feature film Video, 120 mins.)

This compelling coming-of-age feature film takes the viewer on a journey of love and communication needs between Deaf and Hearing worlds. Somalia is an African-American Deaf woman who falls in love with a musician named Xavier, and soon learned that his lack of sensitivity and ignorance regarding her deafness causes irreparable damage to their relationship and ability to communicate.
